AMBULANCE ADDS AUTO-CPR

What is It?

Zoll AutoPulse Resuscitation System, acquired in 2015

Purpose:

Perform chest compressions to resuscitate patients who are being treated for sudden cardiac arrest. The system's pump delivers compressions at a more consistent rate and a wider area of the chest than is possible with hands-on CPR.

How It Works:

Medics align the patient on top of the AutoPulse Platform. The platform contains the drive mechanism and electronics to perform mechanical chest compressions. They close a LifeBand compression pad over the torso. The platform automatically pulls the band tight around the chest and proceeds to rhythmically squeeze the entire ribcage, pumping the heart at 80 compressions per minute.
