Hospital's Emergency Radios Take Over When Weather Knocks Out Power

What Is It? Purpose:	Hospital Emergency Communications Room Dispatch ambulances and other emergency vehicles when storms or disasters have knocked out the county's regular dispatch operations.
Special Radios:	When disaster strikes, the Amateur Radio Emergency Service (ARES) kicks in. These are community volunteers licensed to communicate on amateur ("ham") radios. Amateur radio signals move through the atmosphere on shortwave frequencies. They do not require active electric or cellular connections.
Special Volunteers:	ARES operators report to the hospital communications room or deploy around the county when severe storms threaten. They serve under the direction of the Love County Emergency Manager.
