AMBULANCES EQUIPPED WITH VENTILATORS

What is It?

Impact Ventilator; King Vision Laryngoscope, acquired in 2015.

How It Works: Since 2015, Love County EMS ambulances have been equipped with automated ventilators and camera laryngoscopes. The auto ventilator replaced hand-pumped units. For patients unable to breathe on their own, the ventilator's breathing tube is introduced by mouth into the windpipe by a process called intubation. The ventilator then "breathes" for the patient, blowing air into the lungs and carrying carbon dioxide out.

> The laryngoscope's video camera displays a clear view of the patient's airway, helping the paramedic safely guide a breathing tube between the vocal cords. Paramedics trained in intubation are a distinguishing feature of "Advanced Life Support" ambulances like Love County EMS.
