Vaccine now available to all Oklahoma adults

IT IS FREE - REGISTER ONLINE FOR AN APPOINTMENT

- 1. Open the Oklahoma vaccine registry, www.vaccinate.oklahoma.gov.
- 2. Answer the registration questionnaire, then log off.
- 3. Wait for a Health Department email within 24 hours confirming registration.
- 4. Watch for a future email from the Health Department with a link to booking an appointment.
- 5. Appointments are snapped up in a hurry. Keep returning to the email link until successful at setting an appointment.
- 6. All Oklahoma adults, age 18 and older are eligible to be vaccinated!

- 1. An Oklahoma City man created a website that can notify people when appointments are available. Read about it at www.vaccine-alerts.com.
- 2. The site is handy to use after you've signed up at the state registry and received the email linking you to appointments in step 4 above.
- 3. At www.vaccine-alerts.com, you put in your cellphone number or email address. You will be alerted when the Health Department posts a batch of available appointments.
- 4. Then you need to go (quickly) online to your email link to book an appointment.
